Tour 1 - San Pedro Creek Cultural Park

Max Capacity: 50 attendees

The San Pedro Creek Culture Park (SPCCP) is a landmark project for Bexar County, the San Antonio River Authority and the City of San Antonio. Revitalization of SPC sought to improve flood control, water quality, economic development, connect the community with San Pedro Creek, and share the history of Bexar County and San Antonio. SPCCP project spans two miles through dense development in downtown San Antonio. The project also incorporates 1 of 2 flood tunnels which protects downtown San Antonio during 100-year flood events. Join us on a walking tour as we review methods utilized and lessons learned as the team balanced project goals, budget.



Tour 2 - SAWS H2Oaks Center

Max Capacity: 50 attendees

The H2Oaks Center is located in far south Bexar County at the site formerly known as SAWS Twin Oaks Aquifer Storage and Recovery. The location is now home to three water supplies, operated of desalinated water, aquifer storage and recovery, and local Carrizo Aquifer all from the H2Oaks control room. The facility includes 12 production wells and two injection wells, and a water testing laboratory and treatment processing area. Join us for a tour of the visitor center for an up-close-and-personal look at various areas of the plant, including the control room, lab, and water treatment facilities.
